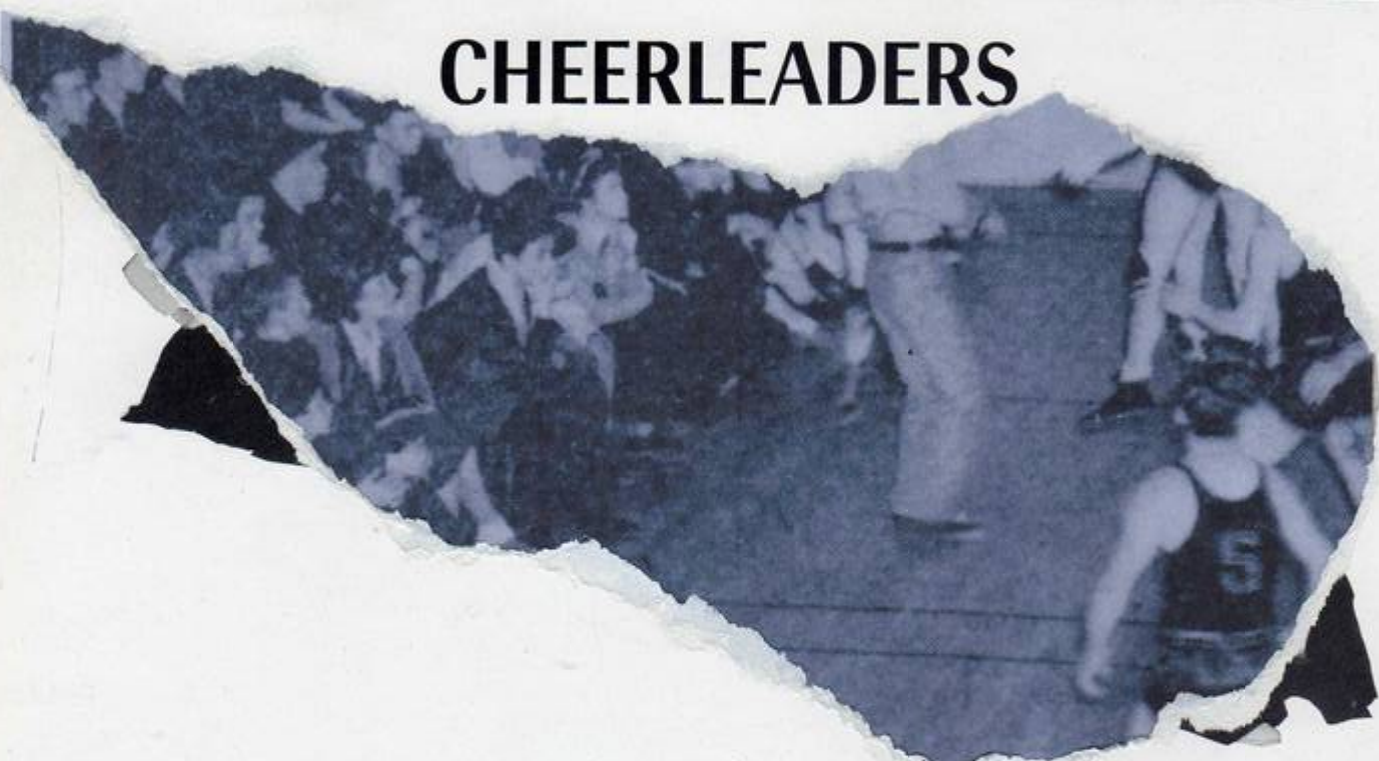

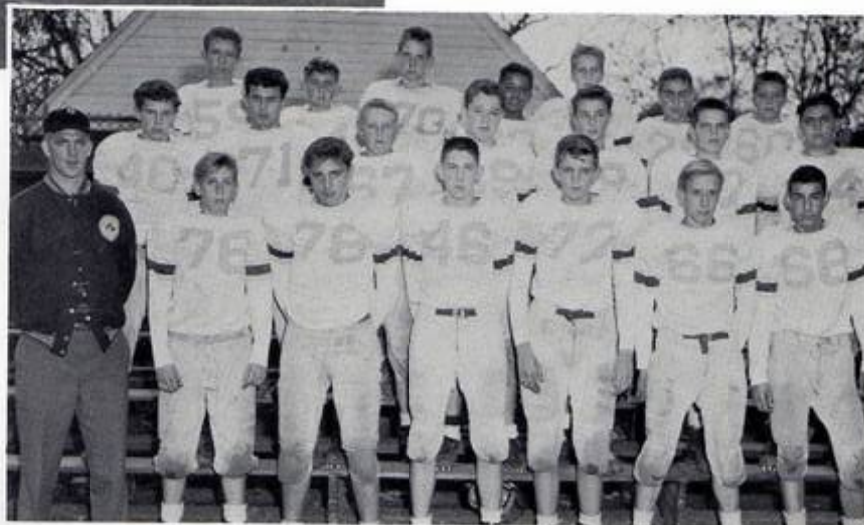

This streak was then broken by a powerful Hackley team which came from behind in the final period to nip B.H.S., 3-2. The Panthers bounced right back with a 2-1 triumph over Scarsdale. Then the booters hit their mid-season tailspin as they suffered successive 2-1 setbacks from Sleepy Hollow and Bronxville and a 4-2 defeat at the hands of Ossining. Here Coach Hasley's men righted themselves and avenged a previous setback by taking Bronxville, 4-2. Bellows scored three times in the second period during their best offensive show of the season. The following game proved one of their best defensive games as they battled mighty Ossining to a 0-0 deadlock. In the final game of the season Bellows evened their record for the year with a 2-0 win over Greenwich.

Prospects look bright for next season as Mr. Hasley will lose only Captain Al Rosenthal, Howie Coan and Roger Lewis from the starting team. Two juniors, Rick Burchell, center forward, Keith Man, goalie, and the sophomore sensation, Paul Strayer, center half, were selected to play in the All-County Soccer game.

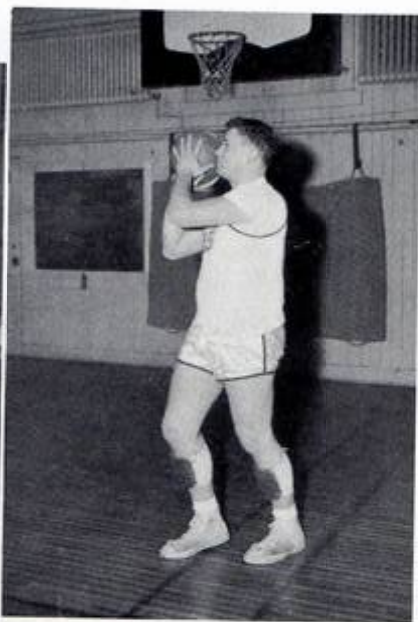

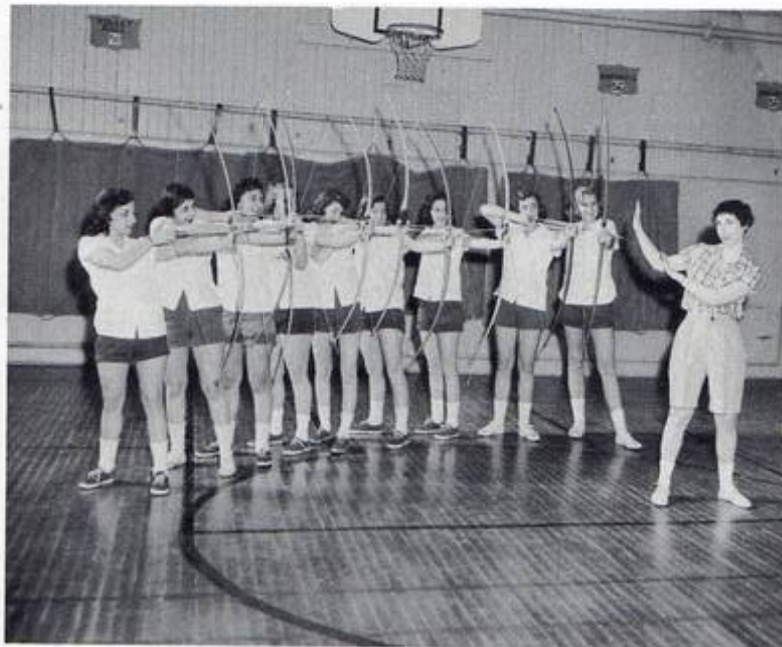

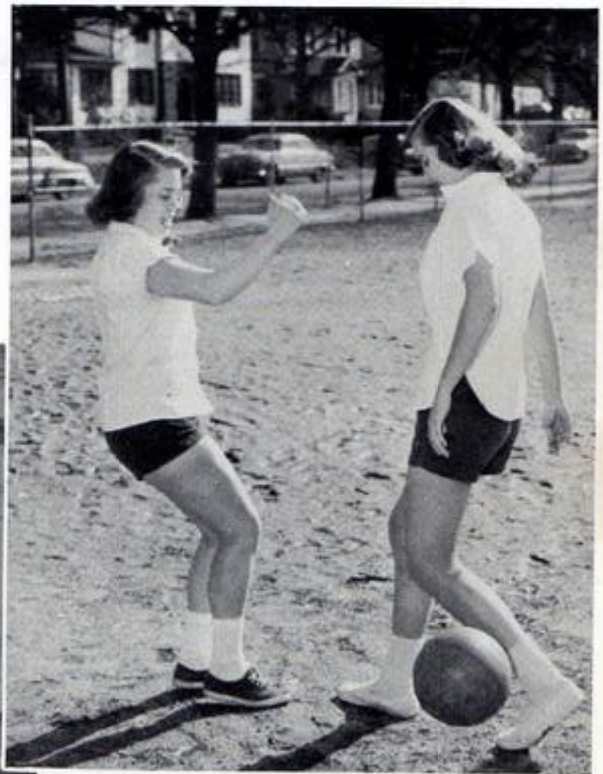
