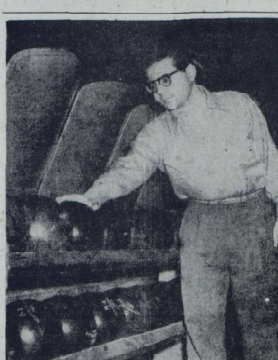

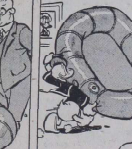

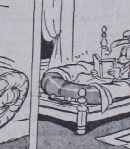

Howard P. Parker, president of the Eye National Bank and of the association, presided and introduced those at the guest table. They included Henry C. Bruns, president of Empire Trust Company; Charles S. Schock, deputy superintendent, New York State Banking Department; Franklin W. Peterson, manager, and Lawrence E. Dignan, special representative of the Bank Relations Department, Federal Reserve Bank of New York.

Mr. Parker recalled that growth of Westchester's banks is shown by the fact that in 1945 Federal War Loan deposits were \$83 million of the \$113 million total. In 1946 they were \$93 million of a \$143 million total in the county.
