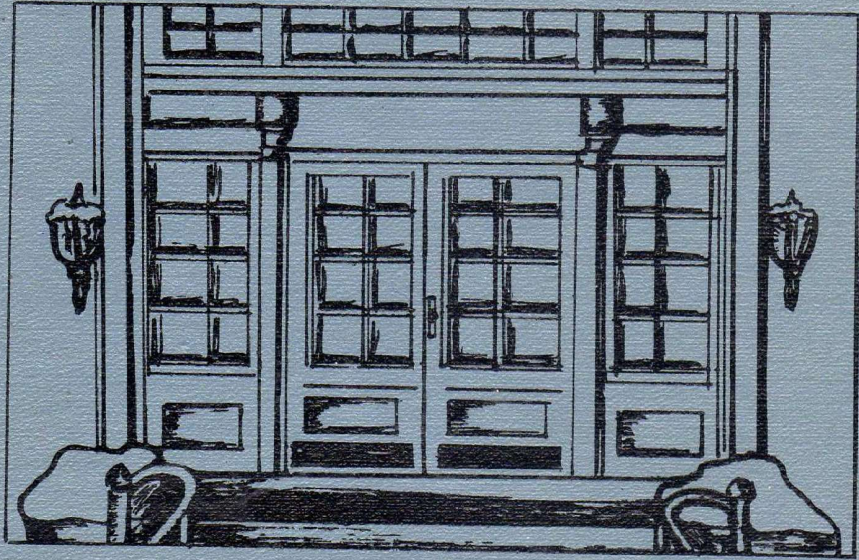

# DEDICATION

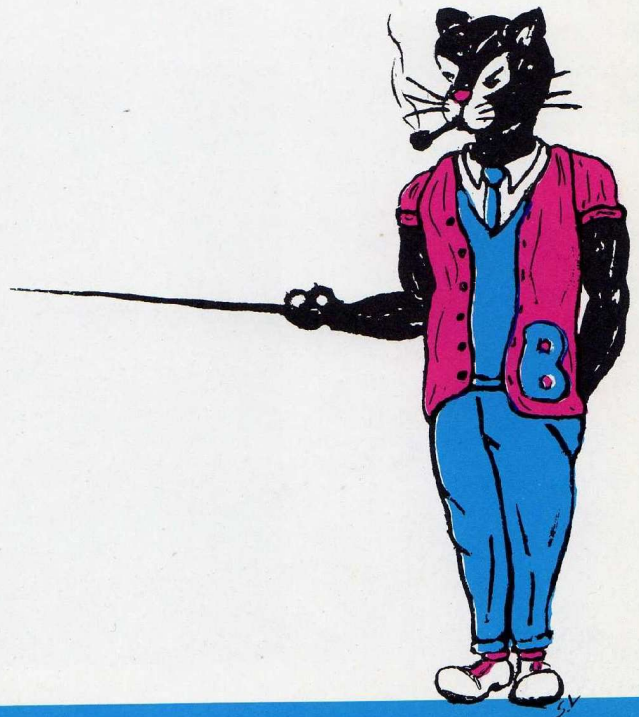

We, as the last graduating class of Bellows, pause for a moment and reflect upon our past six years at school.

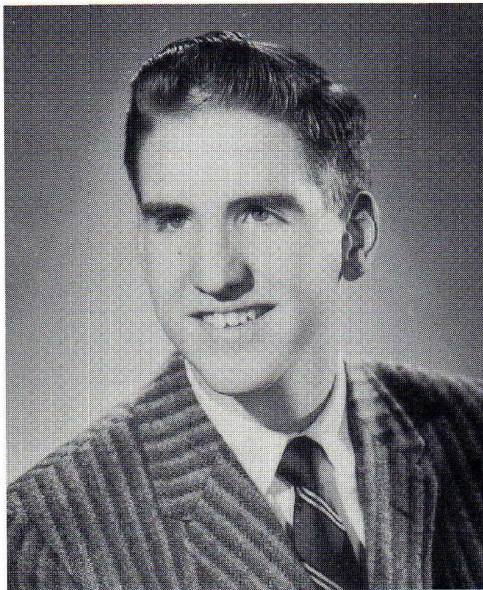
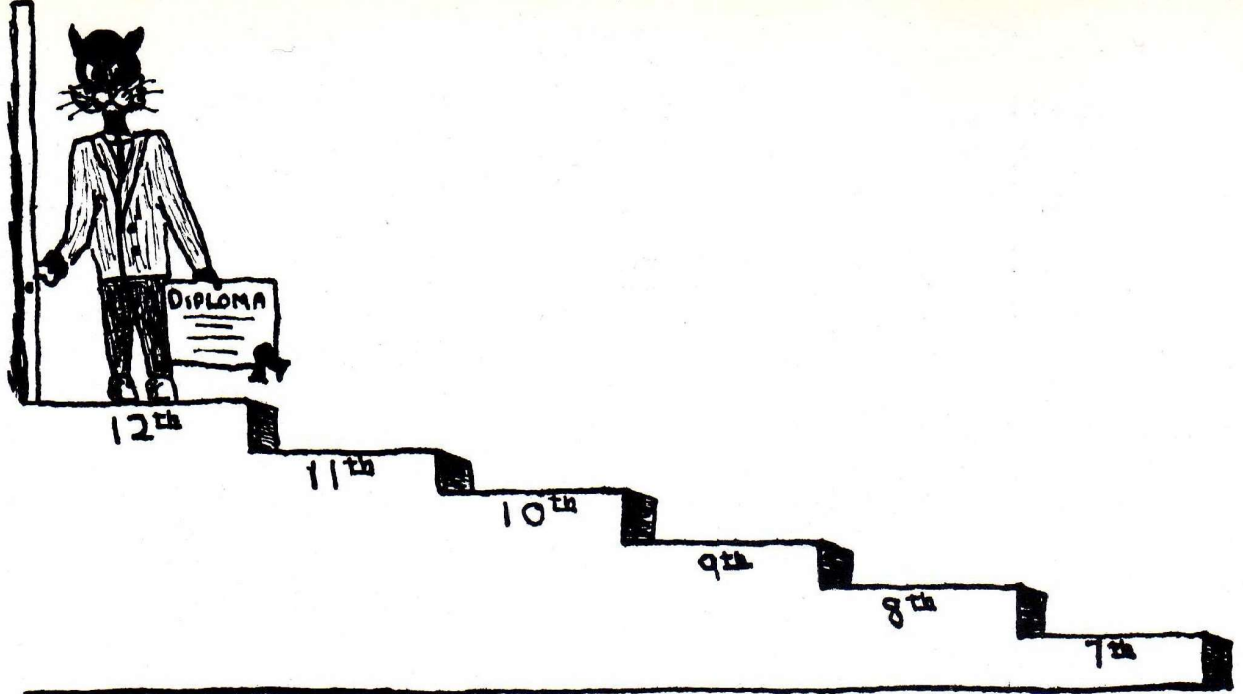

But there are many lettermen returning next year, so watch for one of the top teams in the county from Rye Neck High School next year.

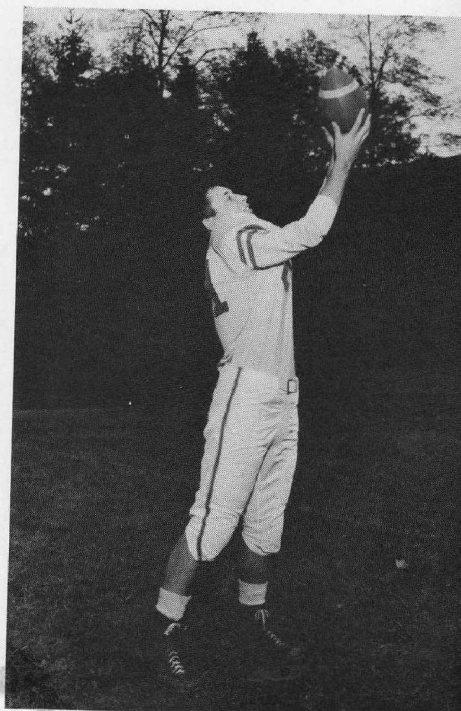

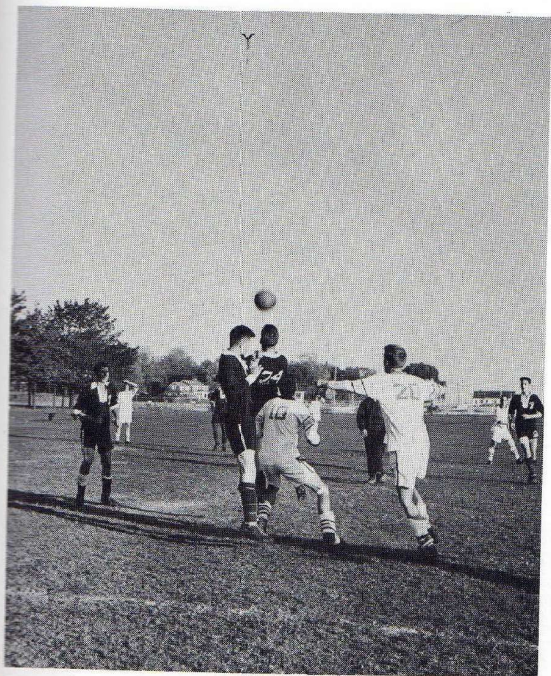

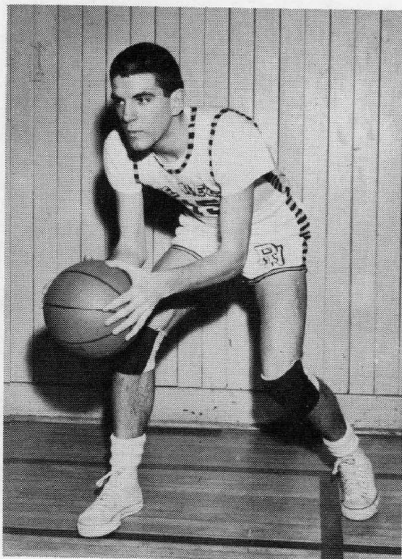
Not since 1951 has the Rye Neck High School enjoyed such a successful basketball season. They compiled a tremendous 14-1 record in regular season competition.

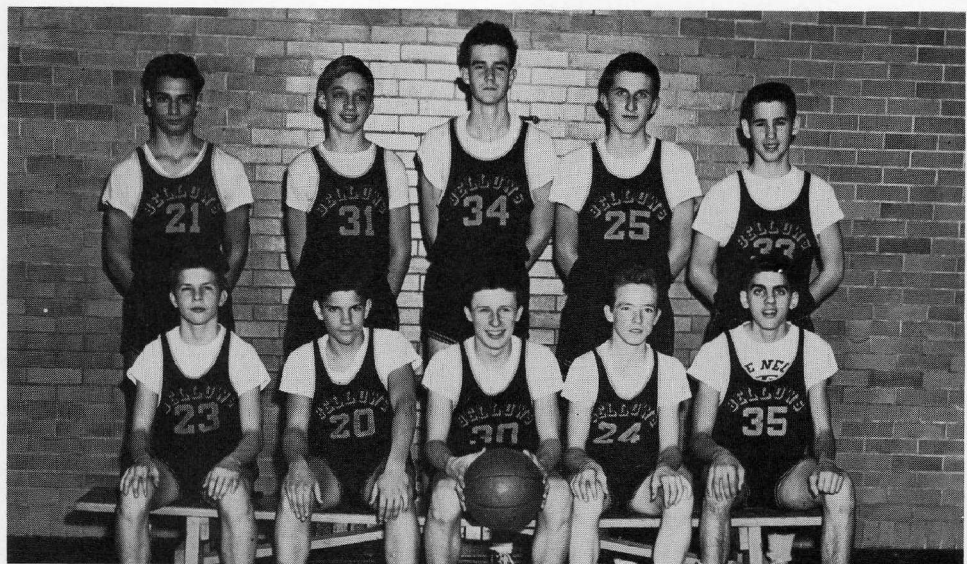
