Strike By Switchmen Spreads To 33 Lines

NEW YORK (AP)—An unusual strike of railroad switchmen highballed across the nation today, putting a brake on the country's rail transportation...

The widest walkout, moving into the third day, appeared growing more critical by the hour. It spanned the nation, hitting directly against 33 railroads in 18 major cities...

Scores of other carriers felt the impact of the fast-spreading work stoppage. So did other industries. Thousands of nonrailroad workers were made idle by the strike...

The government moved to end the strike 20 day critical of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen. But, as they acted, new stoppages were reported...

Sick Sympathizers in N. Y. In New York, some trainmen on the Pennsylvania Railroad's New York Division had stayed away from work, apparently in sympathy with the striking switchmen...

Later, the Pennsylvania and New York Central reported a "higher than normal" number of day shift switchmen reported "sick"...

While the strike has not affected the New Haven Railroad's local commuter service, a walkout at Stony Brook by switchmen there made up the road's through trains delayed departures from New York City early today...

The New York Central said three of 43 men had reported sick on the day shift, and 25 out of 45 scheduled to go on duty at 4 P. M. had reported sick. The men made up trains in the Most Haven Yards and Grand Central Terminal for the New York Central and the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroads...

As a result, the New York Central said three probably would be delays in out-of-town trains this evening. The New York Central placed an embargo on shipments of all perishables and livestock from New York to points west of Buffalo. Carload shipments of other merchandise still were accepted.
