The committee, by a vote of 20 to five, turned down, despite President Roosevelt's personal appeal, the treasury's plan for a graduated tax ranging from 10 to 33 and one-third per cent on profits beyond 10 per cent on invested capital in the last four years.

The net result of this action by the committee will be to permit already profit-fat corporations to avoid paying lasses on profits that range in some cases up to 100 per cent in the period mentioned. On the other hand, a company which has earned but little profit in the past will have to pay a tax on all its income above five per cent of its invested capital.

What that means, in substance, is that the committee has legalized excessive profits made in the last four years. And the argument that the measure if approved will prevent corporations from earning as much in the future does not justify this discrimination.

For these corporations carning huge profits in recent years are of all companies or individuals the most able to meet a large share of the defense program cost. 
